### Franklin County, Virginia

As of December 9th, 2003, A&A officially welcomes Franklin County, VA into our GIS Services fold. The County has agreed in principle to award a contract for GIS Parcel Mapping Services to A&A and CACI via the State VITA contract. The project will include a migration from paper land parcel tax mapping to a digital ArcGIS Geodatabase for Land Records Management. The County is putting the new VGIN Aerial Imagery to good use as digital parcel lot lines will be conflated to match the digital color orthographic imagery. The County is now in the process of developing an Internet mapping application RFP to expand the potential users of the new GIS data.
